Initially, they try not to lose face in front of their peers, but I'm sure it raises awareness and initiates a different way of thinking and, ultimately, behavior for them as well. So, thank you again for that relevant and gripping play, and for the opportunity for talks afterward to not only lighten the mood but also to get to know more about the actors and the audience's reactions or questions. Thank you especially for Sophie and Anthony's realistic and sensitive performances as well as their professional and uncomplicated manner. If possible, I would book them again for the next theatre season."
